Summer Programs

For those students who are interested in increasing their skill base over a short period of time or experience a more intense training opportunity, our summer programs provide longer class times as well as week long sessions. By attending just one camp, this concentrated gym time will provide your child with a 'jump' on his or her skill development. For example, a summer camp (15 hours total) is the equivalent of three months training time (1.25 hrs. X 4 classes X 3 months = 15 hours) at 30% less cost.

There are two options available:

1. Attend any number of the eight week long camps that run from 9 - 12pm or 1 - 4pm, Monday through Friday.
2. Follow a similar program as the current session and attend once or twice per week on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Saturday mornings.

After our scheduled testing weeks May 22nd - June 4th, we will be holding our 3rd achievement presentations. Throughout the awards presentation week, parents are invited to attend the last ten minutes of classes. Your child's group will be called to a podium where her/his coach will present a medallion to your child and the other group members. After all the members in your child's group have received their awards, a round of applause is given. Once all groups have received their awards, class will be concluded.

Does your child have a STEP 1 or STEP 2 Medallion? If so, please bring it to class during awards week (June 12th-18th) for the application of the next level's sticker — mastered medallions are not required.

Note: Please be sure to place your child's name and phone number on the sticker located on the back of the medallion.
